# Federal and State Legislations

- Break Free From Plastic Pollution Act
- Nine states banning single-use plastics and polystyrene





# **Local Ordinances Framework**

- Prohibit the use of any foodware that is not 100% fiber or noncompostable product.
- Prohibition is not applicable to products produced outside city limits.
- Allowable or Alternative Materials –
  ASTM certified
