2) Rodeo Drive Committee Podcast: Season Two "Only on Rodeo Drive"

- The item presented provided the City Council liaisons with information about the second season of the Rodeo Drive Committee's podcast series titled "Only on Rodeo Drive," a podcast dedicated to luxury and fashion on Rodeo Drive. The podcast series was presented and approved by the Council liaisons on February 27, 2020 and formally approved by the City Council on April 21, 2020.
- The Rodeo Drive Committee proposed a second podcast season consisting of eight episodes. The podcast series will provide immersive experiences, behindthe-scenes stories, and histories of some of Rodeo's landmark boutiques. Each episode will be thirty minutes long.
- The Rodeo Drive Committee proposed to continue working with the group from the first series: Bronwyn Cosgrave host Frances Anderton producer and Lyn Winter, executive producer.

Rodeo Drive Committee/Special Events/Holiday Program Committee September 29, 2020 Meeting Highlights

- The Rodeo Drive Committee raised \$30,000 in sponsorship to partially cover the
 cost of the series and requested an additional \$20,000 from the City to cover the
 remainder of the expenses. Funding would be available in the City Council
 approved budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 in the Tourism and Marketing
 budget.
- The Council liaisons reviewed the report, provided feedback, and approved the associated funding request.
